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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$30,453,890 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 twenty-fourth senatorial district, as follows:

7    1.    Ahuimanu Elementary School

8           A.    Plans, design, construction, and  
9                    equipment for an Americans with  
10                   Disability Act accessible pathway;  
11                   ground and site improvements; and

7 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
8 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
9 hereby appropriated out of the state legacy land special fund of  
10 the State of Hawaii for fiscal year 2021-2022.

16 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital  
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 4. (a) The sums appropriated for the respective  
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for  
3 the purposes of this Act as follows:

4 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (8) shall  
5 be expended by the department of education;

6 (2) The sums appropriated in item (9) shall be expended by  
7 the department of health; and

8 (3) The sums appropriated in item (10) shall be expended  
9 by the University of Hawaii.

10 (b) The sum appropriated for the capital project set forth  
11 in section 2 shall be expended for the purposes of this Act by  
12 the department of land and natural resources.

13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
