19 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
20 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
21 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are



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1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
4 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
5 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

6 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 6 shall be  
7 expended by the department of education; and

8 (2) The sums appropriated in item 7 shall be expended by  
9 the department of land and natural resources.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
