A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WANTON WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§183D- Wanton waste; penalties. (a) No person shall
5 wantonly waste the edible portion of a game bird or game mammal.

6 (b) Any portion of the game bird or game mammal not
7 harvested shall be properly disposed of. Proper disposal in the
8 field shall include but not be limited to the cover or burial of
9 all non-edible portions of the game, including any offal, bones,
10 hide, or other waste resulting from the gutting and dressing of
11 a game bird or game mammal.

12 (c) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
13 of a misdemeanor and shall:

14 (1) Be fined not more than \$250 for the first offense;

15 (2) Be fined not more than \$500 for the second offense;

16 (3) Be fined not more than \$1,000 for the third offense;

1 (4) Be fined not more than \$1,000 and serve a mandatory
2 minimum jail sentence of seven days for all subsequent
3 offenses.

4 (d) Each game bird or game mammal wantonly wasted shall be
5 independently subject to a separate fine. Each hunting
6 expedition shall constitute a separate offense.

7 (e) Half of all proceeds collected by the department for
8 violations of this section shall be deposited to the credit of
9 the wildlife revolving fund established pursuant to section
10 183D-10.5 and the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
11 the state general fund."

12 SECTION 2. Section 183D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
14 inserted and to read as follows:

15 "Edible portion" means all four quarters of a game mammal
16 above the knee or hock, including the loin and backstrap, and
17 the breast meat of a game bird.

18 "Wantonly waste" means the intentional leaving or waste of
19 any game bird or game mammal suitable for food by:

20 (1) Abandoning the carcass or any portion of the carcass
21 suitable for food in the field;

- 1 (2) Detaching or removing only the head, hide, antlers,
- 2 tusks, or teeth or any or all of these parts from the
- 3 carcass of a game mammal, or only the feathers of a
- 4 carcass of a game bird; or
- 5 (3) Transporting, hanging, or storing the carcass in a
- 6 manner that renders it unfit for human consumption."

7 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
 9 begun before its effective date.

10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
