1 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
8 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

9 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (4) shall  
10 be expended by the department of education; and

11 (2) The sums appropriated in items (5) and (6) shall be  
12 expended by the department of land and natural  
13 resources.

14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
