BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 11-338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The candidate, authorized person in the case of a
4	noncandidate committee that is a party, or treasurer in the case
5	of a candidate committee or other noncandidate committee, that,
6	within the period of fourteen calendar days through four
7	calendar days [prior to] before any election, makes
8	contributions aggregating more than $[\$500,]$ $\$$
9	receives contributions from any person aggregating more than
10	[\$500,] \$, shall file a late contribution report by
11	means of the commission's electronic filing system on or before
12	the third calendar day [$\frac{prior to}{t}$] $\frac{before}{t}$ the election[$\frac{1}{t}$]
13	provided that this late contribution report does not need to be
14	filed by a candidate or the treasurer of a candidate committee
15	if the candidate is not on the election ballot."
