# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES ON AGRICULTURAL LANDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. Chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
4 designated and to read as follows:

5 "§708- Extended terms of imprisonment for offenses  
6 committed on agricultural lands. (1) The court shall sentence  
7 a person convicted of an offense under part II, III, or IV of  
8 this chapter that is committed while on agricultural land to an  
9 extended term of imprisonment.

10 (2) The extended term of imprisonment shall have a maximum  
11 length of imprisonment as follows:

12 (a) For a class B felony--indeterminate twenty-year term  
13 of imprisonment;

14 (b) For a class C felony--indeterminate ten-year term of  
15 imprisonment;

16 (c) For a misdemeanor--indeterminate two-year term of  
17 imprisonment; and





1 PART III

2 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
3 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
4 begun before its effective date.

5 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on May 6, 2137.
