BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 40-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$40-5 Annual reports. (a) The comptroller shall make an 4 annual report to the governor and to the legislature. Beginning 5 July 1, 2022, the comptroller shall include in the comptroller's annual report a list of all accounts closed by the comptroller 6 during the immediately preceding fiscal year and a list of any 7 8 accounts that remain open but are serving a lapsed program or 9 initiative. 10 (b) The comptroller [may], in the comptroller's yearly 11 report, or in any special report [which] that the comptroller 12 [may at any time think] thinks fit to make, may recommend any 13 [plans]: 14 (1) Plans and suggestions that the comptroller [may think] 15 thinks fit or worthy of adoption for the better

Beginning 7/1/2022, requires the comptroller's annual report to the governor and legislature to include a list of all accounts that were closed by the comptroller during the immediately preceding fiscal year, and a list of accounts that remain open but that are serving a lapsed program or initiative. Effective 7/1/2112. (HD1)

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
