BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 236, Session
- Laws of Hawaii 2016 (Act 236), was enacted to close the 2
- 3 insurance gaps associated with transportation network companies
- by establishing motor vehicle insurance requirements for
- 5 transportation network companies and transportation network
- company drivers. Act 236 is scheduled to repeal on September 1,
- 7 2021.
- 8 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to repeal the
- 9 sunset date of Act 236 and make permanent the motor vehicle
- insurance requirements for transportation network companies and 10
- 11 transportation network company drivers.
- SECTION 2. Act 236, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, is 12
- 13 amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
- 14 "SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- provided that section 2 of this Act shall take effect on 15
- 16 September 1, 2016 [; provided further that this Act shall be
- 17 repealed on September 1, 2021]."
