A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State has some
- 2 of the strongest gun safety laws in the nation, and in 2019
- 3 Hawai'i received an A-minus rating from the Giffords Law Center
- 4 to Prevent Gun Violence. Additionally, Hawai'i had the third
- 5 lowest number of gun deaths per capita among the states in 2019,
- 6 according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
- 7 The legislature is committed to protecting the safety and well-
- 8 being of its citizens. The fact that Hawai'i still allows any
- 9 firearm or rifle with the capacity to fire ammunition of fifty
- 10 caliber or higher is inconsistent with this commitment.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit any firearm or rifle
- 12 with the capacity to fire ammunition of fifty caliber or higher
- 13 except shotguns and muzzle-loading firearms.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 134-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 16 "(a) The manufacture, possession, sale, barter, trade,
- 17 gift, transfer, or acquisition of any of the following is



- 1 prohibited: assault pistols, except as provided by
- 2 section 134-4(e); automatic firearms; rifles with barrel lengths
- 3 less than sixteen inches; shotguns with barrel lengths less than
- 4 eighteen inches; any firearm or rifle with the capacity to fire
- 5 ammunition of fifty caliber or higher except shotguns and
- 6 muzzle-loading firearms; cannons; mufflers, silencers, or
- 7 devices for deadening or muffling the sound of discharged
- 8 firearms; hand grenades, dynamite, blasting caps, bombs, [ex]
- 9 bombshells, or other explosives; or any type of ammunition or
- 10 any projectile component thereof coated with [teflon] Teflon or
- 11 any other similar coating designed primarily to enhance its
- 12 capability to penetrate metal or pierce protective armor; and
- 13 any type of ammunition or any projectile component thereof
- 14 designed or intended to explode or segment upon impact with its
- 15 target."
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on May 6, 2137.
