A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LITTER CONTROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the release of
- 2 balloons inflated with lighter-than-air gas poses a danger and
- 3 nuisance to the environment, particularly to wildlife and marine
- 4 animals. Many animals are attracted to the bright colors of
- 5 balloons and mistake them for food, which can cause an animal
- 6 severe injury or death. Animals are often found entangled in
- 7 balloon strings and, as a result, are injured or strangled to
- 8 death.
- 9 The legislature further finds that several states,
- 10 including California, Connecticut, Florida, New Jersey,
- 11 Tennessee, and Virginia, as well as numerous counties in other
- 12 states, have prohibited the release of balloons inflated with
- 13 lighter-than-air gases.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the intentional
- 15 release of balloons inflated with gas that is lighter than air.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 339, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§339- Intentional release of balloons; prohibition.
5	(a) No person or entity shall intentionally release, organize
6	the release of, or otherwise cause the release of a balloon
7	inflated with a gas that is lighter than air, except for:
8	(1) A balloon released for scientific or meteorological
9	purposes, on behalf of a governmental agency or
10	pursuant to a governmental contract;
11	(2) A hot air balloon that is recovered after launching;
12	<u>or</u>
13	(3) A balloon that is released and remains indoors.
14	(b) Any person or entity who violates this section shall
15	be subject to a civil penalty of no more than \$500 for each
16	offense. For the purposes of this section, the release of
17	multiple balloons at one time shall be considered a single
18	offense."
19	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
20	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
