A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 342H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§342H- Beverages in plastic bottles or rigid plastic
5 containers; prohibition on using state funds to purchase. (a)

6 No state agency shall use state funds for the purchase of
7 beverages in plastic bottles or rigid plastic containers, except
8 as provided in subsection (b).

9 (b) The prohibition in subsection (a) shall not apply to:

10 (1) Public health and safety preparedness, emergencies,
11 investigations, and extended deployments or
12 activations of the office of hazard evaluation and
13 emergency response of the department or the department
14 of defense;

15 (2) Situations in which there is high risk of cross-
16 contamination with non-potable or contaminated water;



- 1 (3) Purchases made in relation to the licensed blind
2 vendor program;
- 3 (4) Purchases of water by the department of land and
4 natural resources for wildland firefighters of the
5 division of forestry and wildlife; and
- 6 (5) Situations in which there are no reasonable
7 alternatives to beverages in plastic bottles or rigid
8 plastic containers, such as large public events, and
9 circumstances in which large quantities of beverages
10 must be distributed for health and safety reasons.

11 (c) For purposes of this section:

12 "State agency" means a department, division, agency,
13 office, board, commission, bureau, or council of the State.

14 "State funds" means any money deposited into or drawn from
15 the state treasury or any special, revolving, or trust fund or
16 trust account of the State. "State funds" includes any money
17 appropriated by the State and transferred to any state agency
18 that is used by the state agency, in whole or in part, to
19 purchase goods or services."

20 SECTION 2. Chapter 342H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
21 amended by amending the title of part III to read as follows:


