A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO GUARANTEE ALL INDIVIDUALS THE RIGHT TO HAVE A CLEAN AND HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article I of the Constitution of the State of
- 3 Hawaii to guarantee all individuals the right to have a clean
- 4 and healthy environment. While the state constitution currently
- 5 mandates a trust obligation of the State to protect Hawaii's
- 6 natural beauty and all natural resources, an amendment to the
- 7 State's Bill of Rights guaranteeing an individual's right to a
- 8 clean and healthy environment is a necessary complement.
- 9 SECTION 2. Article I of the Constitution of the State of
- 10 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 11 designated and to read as follows:

12 "ENVIRONMENTAL RIGHTS

- 13 Section . Each person has a right to a clean and
- 14 healthy environment, including pure water, clean air and healthy
- 15 ecosystems, and to the preservation of the natural, cultural,
- 16 scenic and healthful qualities of the environment."

1 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall 2 be as follows: 3 "Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be amended to 4 provide that each person has a right to a clean and healthy 5 environment, including pure water, clean air, and healthy 6 ecosystems, and to the preservation of the natural, 7 cultural, scenic, and healthful qualities of the 8 environment, as provided by general law?" 9 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored. 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050; 11 provided that this amendment shall take effect upon compliance 12 with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of the State 13 of Hawaii.
