A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that teaching water
- 2 safety at a young age is key to preventing drownings. Ocean
- 3 safety and stewardship courses also help to nurture a sense of
- 4 responsibility and respect for the coastal environment.
- 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 6 department of education to establish and administer an ocean
- 7 safety and stewardship education program for all fourth grade
- 8 public school students.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to subpart C of part II to be
- 11 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- "§302A- Ocean safety and stewardship education. (a)
- 13 The department shall establish and administer an ocean safety
- 14 and stewardship education program to be conducted at each
- 15 <u>elementary public school or a beach or another appropriate</u>
- 16 <u>location for students in the fourth grade; provided that the</u>
- 17 department may provide an opt-out process for elementary public



- 1 schools that have other comparable programs or conduct water
- 2 safety training at a different grade level.
- 3 (b) The department may consult or contract with private
- 4 organizations or instructors for the purposes of this section."
- 5 SECTION 3. Within one hundred eighty days of the effective
- 6 date of this Act, the department of education shall implement
- 7 the ocean safety and stewardship education program as required
- 8 by section 2 of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
