A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ALCOHOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 244D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "beer" to read as follows: 3 ""Beer" means any alcoholic beverage containing no less 4 than 0.5 per cent alcohol by volume and obtained by the 5 fermentation or any infusion or decoction of [barley,] malt, 6 [hops, or any other similar product, or any combination thereof 7 in water, and] wholly or in part, or any substitute therefor, 8 including grain of any kind, bran, glucose, sugar, or molasses. 9 "Beer" includes ale, porter, brown, stout, lager beer, small 10 beer, [and] strong beer, and alcoholic seltzer beverages, but does not include sake, known as Japanese rice wine, or cooler 11 12 beverage." 13 Section 281-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2. 14 amended by amending the definition of "beer" to read as follows: 15 ""Beer" means any alcoholic beverage containing no less 16 than 0.5 per cent alcohol by volume and obtained by the 17 alcoholic fermentation of any infusion or decoction of [barley

- or other grain,] malt, [and hops in water.] wholly or in part, 1
- or any substitute therefor, including grain of any kind, bran, 2
- glucose, sugar, or molasses." 3
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
