- 5 every judgment for child support, including a judgment for
- 6 reimbursement or other arrears, shall be [presumed to be paid
- 7 and discharged on the thirty-third birthday of the child for
- 8 which the order of support was rendered or by the expiration of
- 9 the latest period provided in section 657-5, whichever date is
- 10 later.] enforceable until paid in full."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3021.
