
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 219.1, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act,
2 1920, as amended, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read
3 as follows:

4 "(b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
5 department either alone or together with any other governmental
6 agency, may:

7 (1) Form an insurance company, association (nonprofit or
8 otherwise), pool, or trust;

9 (2) Acquire an existing insurance company;

10 (3) Enter into arrangements with one or more insurance
11 companies; ~~[or]~~

12 (4) Engage in lottery or bingo enterprises pursuant to
13 applicable state law; or

14 ~~[(4)]~~ (5) Undertake any combination of the foregoing; upon
15 such terms and conditions and for such periods, as the
16 commission shall approve, to provide homeowner
17 protection, including hurricane coverage, for lessees



1 participating in such undertaking. Such undertaking
2 shall be subject to the provisions of chapter 431P,
3 including but not limited to section 431P-10(b), and
4 chapter 431."

5 SECTION 2. The provisions of the amendments made by this
6 Act to the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended, are
7 declared to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause,
8 or phrase, or the application thereof to any person or
9 circumstances is held ineffective because there is a requirement
10 of having the consent of the United States to take effect, then
11 that portion only shall take effect upon the granting of consent
12 by the United States and effectiveness of the remainder of these
13 amendments or the application thereof shall not be affected.

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
