
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Moneys in the tourism special fund shall be used by
4 the authority for the purposes of this chapter, provided that:

5 (1) Not more than 3.5 per cent of this amount shall be
6 used for administrative expenses, including:

7 (A) All governance and employment expenses;

8 (B) Organization-wide costs; and

9 (C) \$15,000 for a protocol fund to be expended at the
10 discretion of the president and chief executive
11 officer; and

12 (2) At least \$1,000,000 shall be made available to support
13 efforts to manage, improve, and protect Hawaii's
14 natural environment and areas frequented by visitors."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
