A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRINCE JONAH KUHIO KALANIANAOLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that Prince Jonah
- 2 Kuhio Kalanianaole led efforts to convince the United States
- 3 Congress to pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920,
- 4 under which the department of Hawaiian home lands was created.
- 5 The legislature finds that requiring certain public buildings on
- 6 Hawaiian home lands to display portraits of Prince Kuhio is an
- 7 appropriate way to honor the prince's legacy as the Hawaiian
- 8 Homes Commission Act's author.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to require certain public
- 10 buildings on Hawaiian home lands to display portraits of Prince
- 11 Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 13 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated
- 14 and to read as follows:
- 15 "\$27- Prince Kuhio; portraits; buildings. Any public
- 16 building or structure that is located:

4	(2)	On Hawaiian home lands,
