A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE PROCEDURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 92-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
3 "§92-10 Legislative branch; applicability.
4 Notwithstanding any provisions contained in this chapter to the
5 contrary, open meeting requirements, and provisions regarding
6 enforcement, penalties and sanctions, as they are to relate to
7 the state legislature or to any of its members shall be such as
8 shall be from time to time prescribed by the respective rules
9 and procedures of the senate and the house of representatives,
10 which rules and procedures shall take precedence over this part.
11 Similarly, provisions relating to notice, agenda and minutes of
12 meetings, and such other requirements as may be necessary, shall
13 also be governed by the respective rules and procedures of the
14 senate and the house of representatives[-]; provided that
15 amendments to a bill that are not germane to the prior version
16 of the bill shall have at least one vote in either chamber of
17 the legislature or in both, prior to final adoption."
