SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INSTALL RAISED CROSSWALKS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS ALONG KUHINA STREET.

WHEREAS, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety
Administration, speeding is involved in nearly one-third of all
motor vehicle fatalities in the United States; and
WHEREAS, in Hawaii, speeding is a contributing factor in
nearly fifty percent of all traffic fatalities; and
WWEDENG nodestrian safety should be a priority for the

which are designed to slow down motor vehicle traffic, can be

House of Representatives concurring, that the City and County of
Honolulu is urged to install raised crosswalks along Kuhina
Street at the following intersections:
(1) Kuhina Street and Ahona Street;
(1) Rumma Screet and Anoma Screet,
(2) Kuhina Street and Pailani Street; and
(3) Kuhina Street and Mailani Street; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City and County of Honolulu
officials are urged to seek input from the Ewa Neighborhood
