SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING STATE DEPARTMENTS AND ATTACHED AGENCIES TO TRAIN THEIR BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

WHEREAS, there are over one hundred seventy state boards, 1 councils, authorities, committees, and commissions, hereinafter 2 collectively referred to as "boards and commissions", that are 3 established by the Constitution of Hawaii, state statutes, and 4 5 executive orders; and 6 WHEREAS, these boards and commissions are appointed to give 7 8 citizens a voice in government and provide an opportunity for a cross-section of the State's residents to offer vital input to 9 10 influence decisions that shape the quality of life for the 11 residents of Hawaii; and 12 WHEREAS, the members of boards and commissions must guickly 13 14 become familiar with certain specific laws regarding open meetings, open records, fiduciary duty, and other ethical 15 standards of conduct, in order to ensure the validity of their 16 actions; and 17 18 WHEREAS, upon their appointment, members may not possess 19 knowledge of the mission roles, and responsibilities of their 20 board or commission under applicable laws; programs; processes 21 22 and procedures relevant to the work of the board or commission; and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, the departments and agencies that administratively control or supervise these boards and commissions are the 26 appropriate entities to train and educate members of the board 27 or commission; now, therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 30 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the 31 House of Representatives concurring, that the heads of the 32

departments and agencies that administratively control or 1 supervise a board or commission are urged to provide training 2 for all members of their boards and commissions subject to 84-3 17, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the training provided should 6 7 cover the board or commission's mission, roles, and 8 responsibilities under applicable laws; programs; processes and procedures relevant to the work of the board or commission; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the departments and attached 11 agencies should provide the training at least once per calendar 12 13 year; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 15 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and the 16 heads of each executive department of the state. 17
