SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE, AND OFFICE OF ENTERPRISE TECHNOLOGY SERVICES TO IDENTIFY AND ELIMINATE GAPS IN THE TRACKING OF STUDIES, FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR STUDIES, AND SUBMISSION STATUS OF REPORTS.

WHEREAS, between 2015 and 2020, the Legislature 1 2 appropriated funds and required reports in one hundred Acts; and 3 WHEREAS, of those one hundred required reports, thirteen 4 5 reports were not submitted; of those thirteen, ten reports were funded and not delivered; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Act 71, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, appropriated 8 \$30,000 for fiscal year 2015-2016 and \$15,000 for fiscal year 9 2016-2017 to be expended by the Department of Health to report 10 to the Legislature on the status of the civil monetary penalty 11 special fund, which report has not been submitted to the 12 13 Legislature; and 14 WHEREAS, Act 194, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, appropriated 15 \$2,000,000 out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii 16 for fiscal year 2016-2017 for positions and other operating 17 18 expenditures of the Roads Commission and for repair work, including flood mitigation, installation of drainage 19 20 infrastructure, and road resurfacing; however, the Roads 21 Commission was never established, the appropriation lapsed, and 22 no report was submitted; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Act 231, Session Laws of Hawaii 2001, established that the Legislative Reference Bureau shall develop a system to 25 track and monitor the submission of reports to the Legislature 26 by executive agencies and the Judiciary, and that the system 27 shall encompass all annual and other reports required by law to 28 be submitted to the Legislature, or requested by legislative 29 30 resolution; and



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1 2 WHEREAS, in 2018, the Legislature began accepting reports filed electronically, yet the Legislative Reference Bureau 3 4 cannot identify the status of pending reports, largely due to its manual filing system geared towards receiving and filing 5 6 reports rather than tracking report status; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Finance also cannot 9 ascertain the status of funded studies; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the Office of Enterprise Technology Services developed a Capital Improvement Project Dashboard tracking 12 system that tracks the amount of CIP funds encumbered and 13 expended by department and by month, allowing citizens to see 14 how the funds raised by bond issues are being spent, by whom, 15 and when; now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 18 19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Legislative 20 Reference Bureau, Department of Budget and Finance, and Office 21 of Enterprise Technology Services are requested to identify and 22 eliminate gaps in the tracking of studies, funds appropriated 23 for studies, and submission status of reports; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference 26 Bureau, Department of Budget and Finance, and Office of 27 Enterprise Technology Services are requested to submit a joint 28 report of their findings, actions already undertaken, and 29 recommendations to the Legislature no later than twenty days 30 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2022; and 31 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 33 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the 34 Legislative Reference Bureau, Director of Budget and Finance, 35 and Chief Information Officer. 36 OFFERED BY: 37 38 39
