SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES' DIVISION OF STATE PARKS TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT AN INNOVATIVE STRATEGIC PLAN FOR THE USE OF COCONUT PALM TREES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A SUSTAINABLE FOOD SOURCE.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Park System has over fifty parks 1 encompassing approximately thirty thousand acres across the 2 islands, ranging from landscaped grounds to wild land areas; and 3 4 WHEREAS, current State processes do not allow coconuts from 5 6 the coconut palms in parks to grow into mature fruit due to safety concerns from falling coconuts, nor do they provide for 7 the collection and processing of fallen fruit to distribute as 8 food sources; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the people of Hawaii are committed to creating a 11 sustainable food source where all residents can enjoy longer, 12 healthier lives by combatting hunger and providing safe food 13 access to everyone in our community, especially to our most 14 vulnerable populations; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, promoting innovative strategies of sustainable food sources will reduce waste and promote the sustainable use 18 of lands for food; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the need has been identified to preserve and 21 protect coconut fruits growing from the palm trees. 22 It is essential to the public that fruit trees in state parks and 23 state-owned lands be permitted to be utilized for a variety of 24 purposes, such as a sustainable food source especially to feed 25 those in need; and 26 27 WHEREAS, public outreach has been conducted in various 28 formats to gather opinions and comments regarding the matter. 29 Charity organizations, such as the Hawaii Foodbank and Hawaii 30 Homeless Healthcare Hui, are willing to accept edible coconuts 31

and the Hawaii Foodbank is agreeable to providing drivers to 1 collect donations at various sites if coconuts from public lands 2 were to be collected and processed; now, therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the 6 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land 7 and Natural Resources' Division of State Parks is requested to 8 develop and implement an innovative and strategic plan for the 9 use of coconut palms in state parks and state-owned lands as a 10 sustainable food source; and 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 13 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 14 Board of Land and Natural Resources. 15 16 17 18 OFFERED BY: Key
