## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO USE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT AND CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT MONIES TO RETAIN TEACHERS AND PREVENT FURLOUGHS.

1 WHEREAS, the State's Department of Education is the only 2 public education system in the country that is wholly state 3 funded; and 4 WHEREAS, this singular funding status has resulted in the 5 department of education facing unique challenges to utilizing 6 7 funds provided by the federal government to offset the negative 8 economic impacts of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) 9 pandemic; and 10 WHEREAS, the states that receive certain federal funds, 11 including monies from the Elementary and Secondary School 12 Emergency Relief Funds established by the Coronavirus Aid, 13 Relief, and Economic Security Act, Public Law 116-136, 2020 14 (CARES Act), and the Coronavirus Response and Relief 15 Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021, Public Law 116-260 16 17 (CRRSAA), are required to assure that they will maintain support 18 for education programs during fiscal years 2019-2020 and 2020-19 2021 by meeting certain benchmarks; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the CARES Act created the federal Education 22 Stabilization Fund; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the State, through the Department of Education, 25 must comply with the provisions of the federal Education Stabilization Fund as set forth in section 18006 of the CARES 26 Act to receive and expend CARES Act and CRRSAA monies, which, in 27 part, requires the Department of Education to continue to pay 28 29 its employees; and 30



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WHEREAS, in accepting and expending federal CARES Act and 1 CRRSAA monies, the Department of Education employees must 2 continue to receive their pay; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the State, through the department of education, 5 must also comply with the "maintenance of effort" provisions set 6 forth in section 18008 of the CARES Act; and 7 8 WHEREAS, these provisions require funding for public 9 education to be maintained at the same funding levels as in 10 fiscal years 2017, 2018, and 2019, for those funds that are part 11 of the CARES Act and at a proportional funding level for the 12 CRRSAA; and 13 14 WHEREAS, federal monies received by the State to the 15 Department of Education should be used to offset any budget 16 reductions that would result in the reduction of personnel who 17 are employed at the school level, including any budget reduction 18 that results in a layoff, furlough, or pay reduction; now, 19 20 therefore, 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 22 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021, the 23 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 24 Education is urged to use CARES Act and CRRSAA monies for the 25 retention of teachers and to prevent furloughs; and 26 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to Superintendent of 29 Education and the Chairperson of the Board of Education. 30 31 OFFERED BY: Semette &.
