# SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO REFURBISH THE PUULOA  
BEACH PARK PAVILION.

1           WHEREAS, Puuloa Beach Park at the end of Fort Weaver Road  
2 in Ewa Beach is a popular location for holding celebrations,  
3 conducting gatherings, and enjoying the outdoors; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, the covered pavilion at the park has accommodated  
6 many events over the years, such as birthdays and graduations;  
7 and  
8

9           WHEREAS, the condition of the pavilion and the surrounding  
10 park complex has deteriorated, leaving them in a dilapidated  
11 state; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, a modest investment in refurbishing the pavilion  
14 would result in many benefits; and  
15

16           WHEREAS, separate fees could be charged for reserving and  
17 subsequently using the pavilion, with a portion of the fee  
18 revenue set aside for the costs of the pavilion's upkeep and to  
19 fund other improvements elsewhere in the park complex; and  
20

21           WHEREAS, without any refurbishment or other attention, the  
22 park and pavilion will fall into further disrepair and become a  
23 neighborhood blight instead of serving as a community treasure;  
24 now, therefore,

26           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first  
27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021,  
28 that the City and County of Honolulu is urged to refurbish the  
29 Puuloa Beach Park pavilion as part of a larger plan to renovate  
30 and improve the entire Puuloa Beach Park complex; and

32           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu  
33 is urged to charge fees to reserve and use the refurbished  
34 pavilion and to use a portion of those fees to maintain the  
35 pavilion and fund other improvements to the park complex; and
