## SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS IN  
THE STATE TO VIGOROUSLY ENFORCE AND PROSECUTE OFFENSES  
COMMITTED AGAINST ESSENTIAL WORKERS WHILE ON THE JOB.

1           WHEREAS, the outbreak of the novel coronavirus disease,  
2 SARS-CoV-2, has given rise to the public's reliance upon a  
3 multitude of workers for essential services, such as health  
4 care, grocery and food service, hospitality, airline travel, and  
5 ground transportation; and

7           WHEREAS, essential workers' jobs often involve a high  
8 degree of face-to-face interaction with the public; and

9  
10          WHEREAS, in the course of their employment, essential  
11 workers are required to relay to customers and other members of  
12 the public government-enacted emergency rules and orders; and

13  
14          WHEREAS, in the course of their employment, essential  
15 workers are also required to enforce these rules and orders; and

16  
17          WHEREAS, it is unacceptable that essential workers are  
18 often harassed or confronted, sometimes physically, while trying  
19 to do their jobs by persons who do not wish to follow the  
20 emergency rules and orders; now, therefore,

22          BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first  
23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021,  
24 that all law enforcement officers and prosecuting attorneys in  
25 the State are urged to vigorously enforce and prosecute offenses  
26 committed against essential workers while on the job; and
