# SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO AMEND THE UNITED STATES  
CODE TO PERMIT ALL RETIRED, DISABLED VETERANS TO RECEIVE  
CONCURRENT RETIREMENT AND DISABILITY PAYMENTS.

1           WHEREAS, under federal law, the phrase "concurrent  
2 retirement and disability payments" refers to a retired,  
3 disabled veteran's simultaneous receipt of the veteran's full  
4 retirement payments and disability compensation; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, prior to implementation of the concurrent  
7 retirement and disability payments program, the retirement  
8 payments for all retired, disabled veterans were offset by the  
9 amount of disability compensation received by the veteran; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, the National Defense Authorization Act of Fiscal  
12 Year 2004 amended 10 United States Code section 1414 to permit  
13 retired, disabled veterans who served in the armed forces for  
14 twenty or more years and have a United States Department of  
15 Veterans Affairs disability rating at or above fifty percent to  
16 receive concurrent retirement and disability payments; and

18           WHEREAS, however, the retirement payments for retired,  
19 disabled veterans who are ineligible for concurrent retirement  
20 and disability payments continue to be offset by the amount of  
21 disability compensation received by the veteran; and  
22

23           WHEREAS, in 2017, the Congressional Budget Office estimated  
24 that the annual cost to provide concurrent retirement and  
25 disability payments was \$11,400,000,000; and  
26

27           WHEREAS, the Congressional Budget Office also estimated  
28 that providing concurrent retirement and disability payments to  
29 retired veterans having a disability rating below fifty percent  
30 would cost approximately \$30,000,000,000 over a ten-year period,  
31 and providing concurrent retirement and disability payments to  
32 retired, disabled veterans having less than twenty years of



1 service in the armed forces would cost approximately  
2 \$5,800,000,000 over a ten-year period; now, therefore,

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first  
5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2021,  
6 that the United States Congress is urged to amend 10 United  
7 States Code section 1414 to permit all retired American veterans  
8 who have a service-connected disability to receive concurrent  
9 retirement and disability payments regardless of the veteran's  
10 disability rating or years of service in the armed forces; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
13 Resolution be transmitted to the Majority Leader of the United  
14 States Senate, Speaker of the United States House of  
15 Representatives, and each member of Hawaii's congressional  
16 delegation.
