Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.B. No. 1090, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER RESTRAINTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to:

- Amend the requirements for the restraint of child passengers; and
- (2) Increase certain fines for violations.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Transportation; Hawaii Strategic Highway Safety Plan; Honolulu Police Department; Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women and Children; Juvenile Products Manufacturers Association, Inc.; AAA Hawai'i; and Keiki Injury Prevention Coalition. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from the Hawaii Association for Justice.

Your Committee finds that motor vehicle injuries are one of the leading causes of death among children. The best way to save lives and reduce injuries in the event of an automobile collision is to ensure the use of age and size appropriate car seats, booster seats, and seat belts. This measure will better protect

children by placing them in a safer seating position within the vehicle and securely seated in an appropriate child restraint seat for an increased period of time.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Restoring language to preclude contributory negligence, comparative negligence, and negligence per se arguments from being raised as a defense to failure to properly restrain a child in a child restraint seat; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1090, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1090, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committees on Judiciary and Ways and Means.
