The purpose of this measure is to:

- Require health insurance providers that provide health (1)benefits plans funded by the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund or the state Medicaid agency and health insurance providers providing Medicare Advantage health benefits to submit administrative data to the Health Analytics Program of the Department of Human Services; and
- (2) Require the Health Analytics Program to develop and update an annual plan for the analysis, maintenance, and publication of collected all-claims, all-payer administrative data.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Human Services and Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund Board of Trustees.
