Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B.
No. 834, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO A BLACK CINDER CONE QUARRY
SITE SURVEY,"

The purpose of this measure is to require the Department of
Land and Natural Resources, in collaboration with the County of
Hawaii, to conduct site surveys to identify the most suitable
locations for black cinder cone quarries on the island of Hawaii.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the University of Hawai'i System, County of Hawai'i, Hawaii
Floriculture and Nursery Association, Orchid Growers of Hawai'i,
Hawaii Tropical Flower Council, Hawaii Export Nursery Association,
and one individual. Your Committee received comments on this
measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources.
