"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EDUCATION,"

The purpose and intent of this measure is to require the Department of Education to include the teaching of financial literacy in the personal transition plan requirement for each student beginning with the 2021-2022 school year.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Education, Hawaii Credit Union League, and two individuals.

Your Committee finds that financial education is a lifelong learning process that empowers individuals to plan for their futures. In the past, the educational system has assumed that students will learn important financial skills from their families. This measure will ensure that Hawaii's students receive an education to help them achieve financial success.
