Your Committee on Economic Development, to which was referred
S.B. No. 1202, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TAXATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to make various technical
amendments to chapters 243, 244D, and 245, Hawaii Revised
Statutes, under the jurisdiction of the Department of Taxation.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Taxation. Your Committee received
testimony in opposition to this measure from the Wailoa River and
Reeds Bay Boating and Users Association. Your Committee received
comments on this measure from the Tax Foundation of Hawaii.

Your Committee finds that it is necessary to amend and repeal
various provisions of title 14 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes,
relating to the fuel, liquor, cigarette, and tobacco tax laws, for
the purposes of correcting errors and references, clarifying
language, or deleting obsolete or unnecessary provisions. This
measure adds clarity to the law and allows for more effective
administration of the State's tax laws by the Department of
Taxation.
