Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 399, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ORDERS OF THE CAMPAIGN SPENDING COMMISSION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Provide that certain rights are deemed waived if a preliminary determination of probable cause is rendered during a meeting, subject to the requirements of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the person fails to request a contested case hearing within twenty days of receipt of the preliminary determination; and
- Authorize the Campaign Spending Commission to have the Commission's order confirmed as a judgment by the First Circuit Court, giving the order the same force and effect as any other judgment issued by the circuit courts.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Campaign Spending Commission, Common Cause Hawaii, and one individual.
