The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Clarify the implied consent law to make exceptions for giving a breath, blood, or urine test pursuant to a search warrant or any other basis permissible under the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and state law; and
- (2) Exclude the offense of habitually operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant from qualifying for deferred acceptance of a guilty plea or nolo contendere plea.
