Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 696, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE FESTIVAL OF PACIFIC ARTS," begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1)Extend the date on which the temporary Commission on the Thirteenth Festival of Pacific Arts ceases to exist to August 31, 2025; and
- Permit less than a quorum of members of the temporary (2) Commission on the Thirteenth Festival of Pacific Arts to discuss matters relating to official board business outside a Commission meeting as a permitted interaction under part I of chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to enable them to perform their duties faithfully, provided that the Commission holds a meeting at least once a month.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; Hawaii Tourism Authority; and Commission on the 13th Festival of Pacific Arts and Culture. Your Committee

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.

No. 696, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 696, S.D. 1, H.D. 1.
