Your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce, to which
was referred S.C.R. No. 13 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A
PERPETUAL, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE
SUBMERGED LANDS AT MAUNALUA, HONOLULU, OAHU, FOR THE EXISTING
STORM DRAIN, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE
EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize the Board of Land
and Natural Resources to issue a perpetual, non-exclusive easement
covering a portion of state submerged lands at Maunalua, Honolulu,
Oahu, for the existing storm drain, and for the use, repair, and
maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

Your Committee finds that the existing storm drain fronting
property located in Maunalua, Honolulu, Oahu, and spanning 174
square feet, encroaches onto state submerged lands. Your
Committee further finds that the Department of Land and Natural
Resources granted a perpetual non-exclusive easement to resolve
the storm drain encroachment. This measure authorizes the
granting of a perpetual non-exclusive easement, as required by
state law, for the portion of the identified state submerged lands

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in Maunaloa that have been encroached upon by the existing storm drain, and for the use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 13 and recommends its adoption.
