Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Legislative Reference Bureau.

Your Committee finds that the COVID-19 pandemic has negatively impacted the State's economy, particularly the tourist industry. Your Committee further finds that this significant decrease in the number of visitors has also negatively impacted the State's creative workers.
