The purpose and intent of this measure is to request that the  
Office of Primary Care and Rural Health facilitate discussions  
with key community health and social service organizations in west  
Hawaii and major health care stakeholders in Senate District 3 to  
address the health and wellness needs of the most vulnerable  
communities by aligning the goals and objectives of key  
organizations into a 2030 One Shared Health Vision Plan.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the  
Department of Health.

Your Committee finds that the purpose of the "One Shared  
Vision" plan is to improve public health by strengthening  
collaboration and communication among all sectors of the health  
care community. Your Committee also finds that establishing a  
strong health network based in west Hawaii in accordance with the



One Shared Vision plan would allow the region to serve as a model for the State.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.R. No. 22 and recommends its adoption.
