### AMENDED AGENDA

The following measure(s) has been ADDED to the agenda: HB416

HB 237 RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES. AGR, FIN

<u>Status</u> Appropriates funds to the department of agriculture for the control of

the two-lined spittlebug and recovery of the rangelands damaged by

the invasive pest.

HB 830 RELATING TO THE IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LAND AGR, FIN

Status QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL COST TAX CREDIT.

Clarifies that a taxpayer can claim the credit in the third taxable year after they apply for the credit, rather than in any taxable year. Extends the time that the department of agriculture may certify the important agricultural land qualified agricultural costs tax credit from 12/31/2021

to 12/31/2030.

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<u>HB 1375</u> RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE AGR, FIN

Status REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST MAUIGROWN COFFEE, INC. Extends the authorization to issue special purpose revenue bonds to

assist MauiGrown Coffee, Inc., with the operation and expansion of its

farm and mill.

HB 1271 RELATING TO THE AGRIBUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AGR, FIN

Status CORPORATION.

Dissolves the agribusiness development corporation and transfers all lands and staff, except for the executive director, to the department of

agriculture.

### **DECISION MAKING**

The following measure(s) were previously heard on February 10, 2021. No public testimony will be accepted.

HB 416 RELATING TO SECTION 711-1109, HAWAII REVISED AGR, JHA

Status STATUTES.

Prohibits certain restraints and tethers that endanger, or deny sustenance, to a dog. Authorizes the court to assess fines, order performance of community service, require mental health counseling, or order attendance at educational classes concerning animal abuse

prevention in addition to or in lieu of other penalties.

### DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least <u>24 hours</u> prior to the hearing. Testimony received after this time will be stamped late and left to the discretion of the chair to consider. While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may not be processed.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.

The chair may institute a per-testifier time limit.
