Provides that the analysis is not required for an electric or a gas utility's routine system replacements or determinations that do not pertain to capital improvements or operations. (SD1)

Authorizes advanced practice registered nurses to order and certify home health care for medicare patients. Authorizes advanced practice registered nurses to certify whether a person is totally disabled under the state income tax code. Authorizes

advanced practice registered nurses to make capacity determinations. Adds advanced practice registered nurses as primary providers in advance mental health care directives.
