SB 1311, SD2 RELATING TO SUSTAINABLE SCHOOLS. EDN/EEP, JHA

(SSCR936) Requires the department of education to establish food waste and zero-Status emission vehicle goals as part of the sustainable schools initiative.

Requires annual reports to the legislature. (SD2)

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SB 1384 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDN, FIN (SSCR678) Provides that the prohibition against serving two consecutive terms not Status to exceed eight consecutive years pursuant to section 26-34(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall not apply to the representative of Hawaiian medium early learning providers' term limit. Repeals on June 30, 2025. SB 1385, SD2 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDN, FIN (SSCR405) Requires the department of education to develop a reorganization plan to provide students and schools with centralized transportation Status services. (SD2) RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. EDN, FIN SB 811 (SSCR673) Requires the department of education to publish a weekly report on Status schools that have reported COVID-19 cases. SB 466, SD2 RELATING TO A SCHOOL FACILITIES AGENCY. EDN, FIN (SSCR921) Amends Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, to require that the **Status** school facilities agency complies with the Hawaii Public Procurement Code. Authorizes the school facilities agency to have additional powers and duties. Specifies additional uses for the school facilities special fund. Provides the executive director of the school facilities agency with authority relating to capital improvement projects for the school facilities agency. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2) SB 808, SD2 RELATING TO THE SCHOOL FACILITIES AGENCY. EDN. FIN (SSCR969) Describes the powers and responsibilities of the school facilities Status agency by amending chapter 302A, part VI, subpart C and Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020. Transfers the total fund balance in the state educational improvement fund to the school facilities special fund by a certain date. Makes appropriation. Effective 7/1/2050. SB 516, SD1 (SSCR958) Status

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

Requires the State board for career and technical education to oversee and review annually statewide data collection processes and reporting requirements related to the student attainment of industry-recognized credentials. Requires certain agencies to collect and report disaggregated data on students' attainment of industry-recognized credentials. Requires certain agencies to pursue data-sharing agreements with credentialing entities. Requires an annual report to the governor and legislature. (SD1)

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least <u>24 hours</u> prior to the hearing. Testimony received after this time will be stamped late and left to the discretion of the chair to consider. The chair may institute a per-testifier time limit.
