SB 850 RELATING TO BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE FOR EET, WAM

Status & RURAL COMMUNITIES.

Testimony

Creates a task force jointly convened by the department of transportation and department of business, economic

development, and tourism to provide equitable broadband access for historically marginalized, unserved, and underserved rural communities. Requires the task force to apply for federal moneys for broadband access. Requires the departments' report to include the findings of the task force and an accounting of amounts received from the CARES Act and Emergency Coronavirus Relief Act of 2020 and grants disbursed by the State for broadband infrastructure for rural communities.

SB 935 RELATING TO AEROSPACE. EET, JDC

Establishes the Office of Aerospace Development in the Hawaii

Status & Technology Development Corporation instead of the Testimony

Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.
Repeals the Pacific International Space Center for Exploration
Systems. Transfers the rights, powers, functions, and duties of the Pacific International Space Center for Exploration Systems

to the Office of Aerospace Development.

SB 916 RELATING TO TAXATION. EET, WAM

Status & Testimony

Specifies that the \$1,000,000 of transient accommodations tax revenues currently allocated to operate a Hawaiian center and the museum of Hawaiian music and dance may also be used to

plan, design, and construct these facilities at an unspecified

location.

**SB 938** RELATING TO TOURISM. EET, WAM Specifies that moneys in the tourism emergency special fund Status & are to be used exclusively for emergency measures directly Testimony related to safety and security initiatives necessary to respond to any tourism emergency. **SB 950** RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY. EET, WAM Requires that the 3.5 per cent cap on spending from the tourism Status & special fund to include all governance and employment **Testimony** expenses and organization-wide costs as administrative
