| <u>SB 788</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u>  | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Requires that past performance be considered in the bid<br>selection of contractors for certain contracts. Requires<br>procurement officers to consider past performance and conduct<br>past performance evaluations and maintain the record of the<br>evaluations.  | GVO, WAM     |
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| <u>SB 789</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u>  | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Establishes a special procurement process for the procurement<br>of goods and services. Requires the procurement policy board<br>to establish procedures for use of the special procurement<br>process by rules. Requires the head of a purchasing agency to<br>prepare a procurement plan and submit the plan to the Attorney<br>General or corporation counsel. Requires the head of a<br>purchasing agency to electronically post, for at least one year,<br>public notice of special procurement contracts within seven days<br>of the contract award. | GVO, JDC     |
| <u>SB 1017</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u> | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Implements certain recommendations of the procurement policy<br>review conducted pursuant to House Resolution No. 142,<br>Regular Session of 2016. Requires the state procurement office<br>to submit a report to the legislature regarding its progress in<br>implementing the procurement policy review recommendations.   | GVO, WAM/JDC |

| <u>SB 1035</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u> | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Authorizes the State Procurement Administrator to develop and<br>administer a procurement automation system, authorizes the<br>State Procurement Administrator to charge and collect an<br>administrative fee to cover the costs of the procurement<br>automation system, establishes a procurement automation<br>system special fund, and supports the State Procurement<br>Administrator's final decision on investigations of procurement<br>policy and compliance.                            | GVO, WAM     |
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| <u>SB 1207</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u> | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Amends section 103D-307, Hawaii Revised Statutes,<br>Emergency Procurements, to add equipment failures, repairs to<br>public property to protect against further loss of, or damage to,<br>public property, to prevent or minimize serious disruption in<br>continued functioning of government services. Replaces Chief<br>Procurement Officer approval with an accounting report to the<br>Legislature within sixty days after the end of the fiscal year in<br>which the procurement was made. | GVO, WAM/JDC |
| <u>SB 1329</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u> | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Creates time limits to resolve protests to the awards of<br>competitive sealed proposal contracts and procurements of<br>professional services.   | GVO, JDC     |
| <u>SB 1391</u><br><u>Status &amp;</u><br><u>Testimony</u> | RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.<br>Requires the procurement policy board to adopt specific<br>procurement rules relating to life-cycle cost analysis by<br>December 31, 2021.  | GVO, WAM     |
