HB 1291, HD1 (HSCR785) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SCHOLARSHIPS. Allows applicants for the University of Hawaii and students enrolled at a community college campus who graduated from a public high school in the State with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and qualified for and received special education services for two or more years during enrollment in grades kindergarten through twelve to be eligible for the Hawaii state scholars program and the Hawaii community college promise program, respectively. HB 1067, HD1 (HSCR791) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Removes the sunset provision in Act 42, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018. Effective 7/1/2060. (HD1)	HRE, WAM/JDC

<u>HB 1069, HD1</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII CANCER RESEARCH SPECIAL	HRE, WAM
(HSCR792)	FUND. Amends the reporting requirement on the Hawaii cancer
