Clarifies that the representative of labor on the Hawaii labor relations board be a person selected by a majority of the exclusive representatives of the collective bargaining units. Establishes procedures for removal of the representative of labor on the Hawaii labor relations board. (HD1)	LCA, JDC
HB 670, HD1 (HSCR679) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM. Authorizes forfeiture of certain ERS benefits, pursuant to court order, for state or county employees and designated beneficiaries who are convicted of an employment-related felony. (HD1)	LCA, JDC/WAM
HB 1253, HD3 (HSCR869) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES. Prohibits employers, with certain exemptions, from requiring employees to download mobile applications to the employees' personal communication devices, terminating or otherwise discriminating against employees for refusing to download mobile applications, or discharging or discriminating against employees for filing complaints concerning these unlawful practices. Effective 12/25/2040. (HD3)	LCA, JDC
