Authorizes the director of labor and industrial relations to prohibit the operation of pressure retaining items, amusement rides, and elevators and kindred equipment if inspection fees or fines are not timely paid. HB 930, HD1 (HSCR807) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM INVESTMENTS. Exempts certain specific types of alternative investment fund information from disclosure under chapter 92F, HRS, the disclosure of which would put the system at a competitive disadvantage and frustrate its legitimate government investment function.
