\*HEARING PDP-ECD 02-04-21 \*

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HB 723 RELATING TO PANDEMIC RESPONSE. PDP/ECD, FIN

Authorizes use of funds appropriated from the emergency and budget reserve fund, from the amounts received by the State from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) Act, for the purchase and distribution of personal protective equipment and industrial hygiene products to state departments and attached agencies.

Effective retroactive to 7/1/2020.

HB 724 RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. PDP/ECD, JHA,

Prohibits the application of travel restrictions implemented during a state of emergency or local state of emergency to essential workers

unless the application of those travel restrictions to essential workers has first been approved by the governor. Defines essential workers for

this purpose.

HB 1324 RELATING TO COMMERCIAL PROPERTY RENT RELIEF. PDP/ECD, CPC,

Status Establishes a commercial rent relief grant program. Requires that FIN

the commercial rent relief grants be given priority for moneys received through federal funding. Appropriated funds.
