RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS AND RECORDS.

PSM, JDC

Allows state boards to hold meetings closed to the public to Status & consider statements and information obtained from witnesses or Testimony victims during an investigation into the hiring, evaluation, dismissal, or discipline of an officer or employee, or of charges brought against the officer or employee. **SB 182** REGARDING THE GENERAL POWERS AND LIMITATION OF PSM, JDC THE COUNTIES. Status & Reaffirms the State's authority over the counties on laws and Testimony rules regarding issues of statewide jurisdiction. **SB 653** RELATING TO INFORMAL MEETINGS. PSM, JDC Exempts members of a county council from the limitation on the Status & number of members that may attend an informational meeting or **Testimony** presentation on matters relating to official county council business for purposes of permitted interactions. Clarifies that such meetings shall be meetings that are open to the public. RELATING TO COMMUNITY MEETINGS. PSM, JDC **SB 698** Exempts members of a county council from the limitation on the Status & number of members that may attend an informational meeting or **Testimony** presentation on matters relating to official board business, including a meeting of another entity, legislative hearing, convention, seminar, or community meeting. Clarifies that such meetings shall be meetings that are open to the public for

purposes of permitted interactions.
