<u>SB 512, SD1</u> (SSCR69) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INCENTIVES. Removes the \$10 per visit per day cap on the dollar-for-dollar match received by supplemental nutrition assistance program beneficiaries under the Hawaii healthy food incentive program, also known as the double up food bucks program. Specifies that healthy proteins are eligible purchases under the program. Makes an appropriation to the department of agriculture to expand funding for the program. (SD1)	AEN, WAM
<u>SB 1232, SD1</u> (SSCR110) <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO LIQUOR. Beginning July 1, 2021, establishes a \$0.10 per drink surcharge in addition to the liquor tax. Repeals June 30, 2024. (SD1)	CPN, WAM
<u>SB 1385, SD1</u> (SSCR78) <u>Status &</u> Testimony	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Requires the department of education to develop a reorganization plan to provide students and schools with centralized transportation services. Requires the department of education to develop a plan to provide students with more locally produced food. Requires the department of education to report to the legislature. (SD1)	EDU, WAM
<u>SB 1353</u> (SSCR94) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE HAWAII STATE ENERGY OFFICE. Expands the duties of the Hawaii State Energy Office to include developing opportunities for economic development. Transfers certain duties relating to energy efficiency, renewable energy, energy resilience, and clean transportation related incentives, programs, and goals from the Chief Energy Officer to the Hawaii State Energy Office.	EET, WAM

<u>SB 1121, SD1</u> (SSCR100) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HOUSING. Exempts housing developed by the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands from general excise taxes. (SD1)	HWN, WAM
<u>SB 715, SD1</u> (SSCR99) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST PUEO DEVELOPMENT, LLC. Authorizes the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds for a master planned development proposed by Pueo Development, LLC, on Hawaiian home lands. (SD1)	HWN, WAM
<u>SB 556, SD1</u> (SSCR53) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO GRANTS. Specifies that legislators and organizations with a current legislator on its governing board shall not be eligible to receive a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Effective 01/01/2022. (SD1)	JDC, WAM
<u>SB 662, SD1</u> (SSCR59) <u>Status &</u> Testimony	RELATING TO TAX CREDITS. Requires that new income tax credits established or renewed after 12/31/2021 include a 5-year sunset or an annual reduction. (SD1)	JDC, WAM
SB 29, SD1 (SSCR52) Status & Testimony	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE IX, SECTION 6, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION, TO REQUIRE THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO PLAN TO PRODUCE ENOUGH HOUSING TO MEET DEMAND IN THEIR MANAGEMENT OF POPULATION GROWTH. Amends the constitution to require the State to plan to provide enough housing to meet demand in its management of population growth. (SD1)	JDC, WAM
<u>SB 60</u> (SSCR81) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SPECIAL NUMBER PLATES. Authorizes the issuance of special number license plates representing the Polynesian Voyaging Society for electric vehicles.	TRS, WAM
SB 772, SD1 (SSCR86) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Authorizes the issuance of special license plates to support forest conservation and ocean conservation, with proceeds from the program to be used to fund conservation efforts at the State's beaches, nearshore environment, and forests. Increases the initial application and renewal fees for special number plates from \$25 to \$100. (SD1)	TRS, WAM
