The following measure(s) were previously heard in their respective subject matter committees:

HB 552, HD1, SD1 (SSCR1225) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT. Establishes clean ground transportation goals for state agencies on a staggered basis until achieving a one hundred per cent light-duty motor vehicle clean fleet by 12/31/2030. Requires the Hawaii state energy office to lead the efforts to incorporate energy efficiency, renewable energy, energy resiliency, and clean transportation to reduce costs and achieve clean energy goals across all public facilities. Requires that all new light-duty passenger vehicles purchased for the state's fleet are zero emission vehicles and the comptroller may authorize an exemption for new fleet vehicle procurement. Requires that the vehicle selection criteria include one hundred percent biodiesel fueled vehicles. Allows state and counties to include trees and plants with lifespans longer than twenty years as a part of capital improvement projects. Adds "green infrastructure" definition. Revises definitions for "capital investment costs" and "construction "costs". Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	EET/TRS, WAM
HB 558, HD2 (SSCR1129) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CLEAN ENERGY FINANCING. Creates the clean energy and energy efficiency revolving loan fund in the Hawaii green infrastructure special fund to be administered by the Hawaii green infrastructure authority. Amends and expands the purpose of the revolving sub-fund for state agencies and also includes the electrification of fleet vehicles. Repeals the building energy efficiency revolving loan fund. Appropriates loan ceiling. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD2)	EET, WAM
